

DIY BRAIDED ROPE CHRISTMAS WREATH

Step by Step Guide

What You'll Need:

- 9m * 10mm jute rope
- 1,5 m wire
- 1m jute burlap
- hot glue gun

- clear tape (or any kind of tape)
- decorated garland
- pinecones (optional)
- scissors

Step 1



Measure out 3 x 3 m pieces of rope. Fold each one in half and lay them down next to each other. You should have 3 sections with 2 strands now.

Step 2



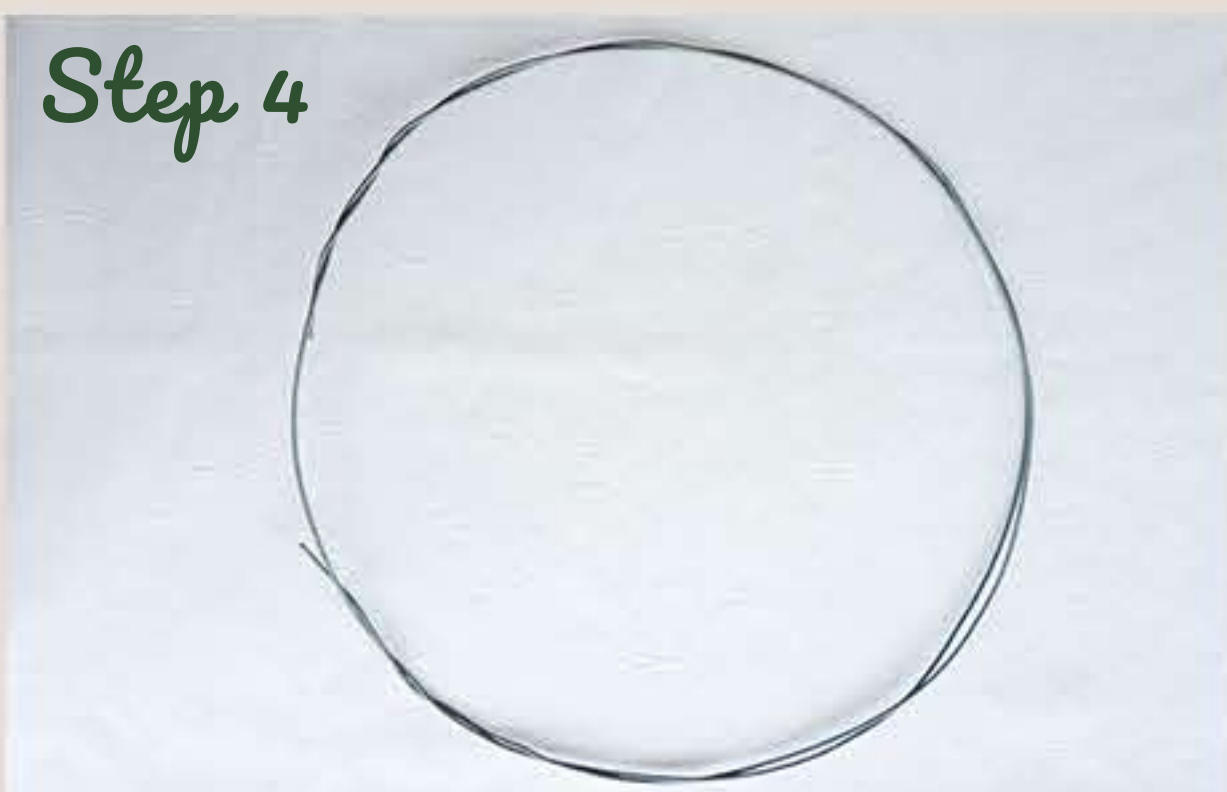
Secure the strands to the work surface with clear tape. Start braiding by taking the left section over the middle section. Then take the right section and cross over the new middle section.

Step 3



After you finish braiding the rope, secure the ends with a hot glue gun. We will hide this section with ornaments later.

Step 4



Take the piece of wire and form a circle. To make it sturdier, double it.

Step 5



Glue the back of the rope wreath (choose the less aesthetic side) to the wire circle in multiple points.

Step 6



Take your garland and cut it into little pieces. It is best to have pieces with different length.

Step 7



Take the longer pieces and glue them to the wreath where the ends meet.

Step 8



Glue the smaller pieces to the longer pieces. Arrange them to your liking.

Step 9



Take the burlap and fold it 3 times around itself using your hand.

Step 10



Tie the bow in the middle using a small piece of wire, then divide the layers and fluff the bow.

Step 11



Glue the bow to the middle of the wreath and conceal the wire by attaching a small pinecone to it with the hot glue gun.

Step 12



After the glue dried your wreath is ready to hang it on the door.
